

# Rodeo Checklist

### State Fair Rodeo

#### **Arrival Time:**

Contestants and families can arrive on Friday after 6 PM. If you arrive Friday you may have to park outside of the gate until the other events are finished. The Meadow Event Park 13191 Dawn Blvd. Doswell, VA 23047

#### **Performances:**

The performance will be 4 PM Saturday slack will be at 7 PM if needed and starting at Noon Sunday. Church service will be at 9 AM on Sunday.

#### **Mutton Busting:**

We will be doing a mutton busting prior to our rodeo each day. The check in will be from 2-3 PM and the mutton busting will be 3-4 PM on Saturday. The check in will be 10-11 AM and the mutton busting will be 11AM - Noon on Sunday. Anyone that is willing to help please let me know.

#### **Stalls:**

There are limited stalls available on site; they are \$40 for the weekend. There is a \$5/day horse haul in fee if you are not using stalls.

#### **Trailer/Camper Hook-ups:**

Campsites are first come, first serve and are done through the State Fair office.

#### **Admission:**

Each contestant will receive three tickets, one for themselves and two additional. Each family will be given 1 parking pass, there are not additional parking passes available. Each contestant can purchase up to 4 additional tickets for \$20 each.

#### **Arena Tear Down:**

Arena tear down will be immediately following the performance on Sunday. All help is appreciated so that we can get this done quickly.

#### **Mandatory Contestant Meeting:**

Contestant meeting for High School/Junior High/Maverick will begin at 2:30 PM on Saturday. All contestants must attend meeting and be in dress code. For safety purposes, contestants should not be on horseback or bring their horses to the meeting.

#### **Shirt Color:**

**Rodeo Dress Code for Contestants & Parents (volunteers working in the arena and waiting with contestant near the entry gate):**

- Back number (*not required of parents/volunteers*)

Entry fees have remained the same and are required for ***EACH*** rodeo. See the fee schedule below. *Entry fees **MUST** be paid the Monday PRIOR to the rodeo by Paypal or a check mailed to Brandy Slaughter, 6421 Cattail Rd, Charles City, VA 23030.* There is a \$10.00 Administration fee that is due per weekend, per contestant.
